had a quiz where I printed pictures of British landmarks and the residents had to guess what it was.

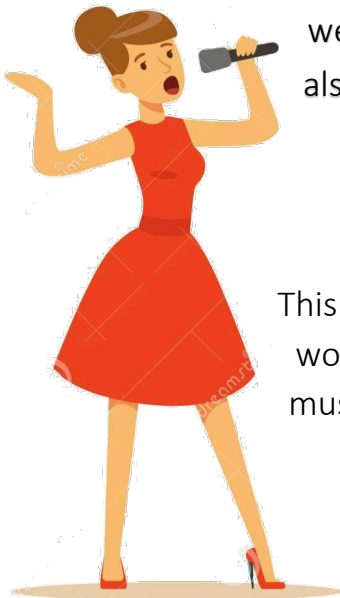
AFTERNOON TEA
