This month we welcomed our new residents Ruth and Bob and our new carer Amala to the Glenview Family.

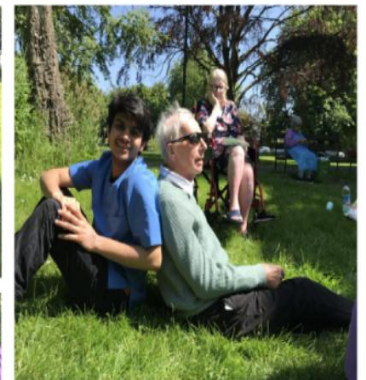
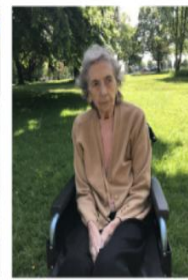
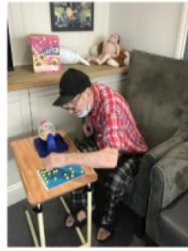
