In May we have singer Shannon performing on the 1st at 10.30am and G-Fitness with Deborah on May 3rd at 1.30pm. All are welcome to join.

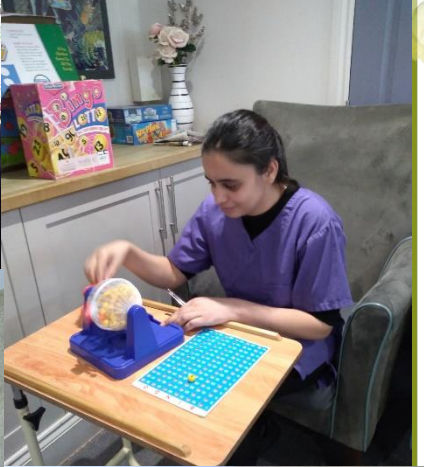
This month we welcomed residents Peter and Betsie. We also welcomed Jerico our new nurse to the Glenview family.

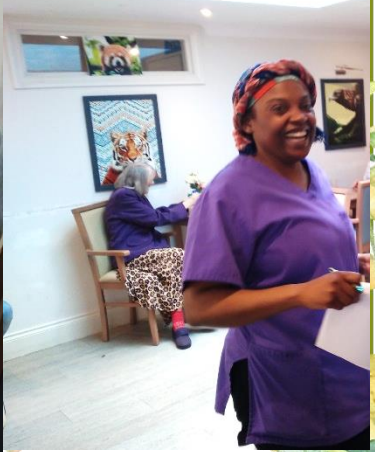
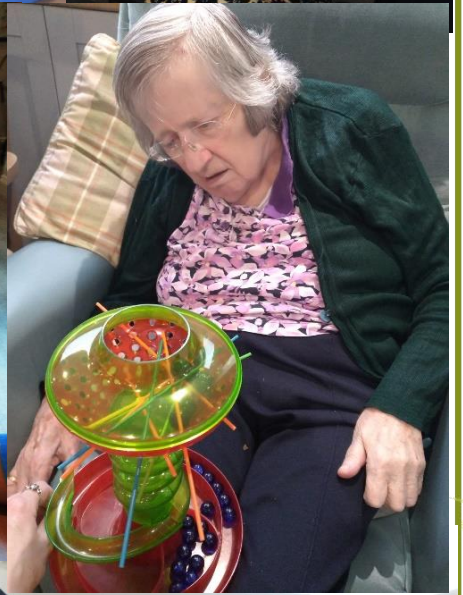


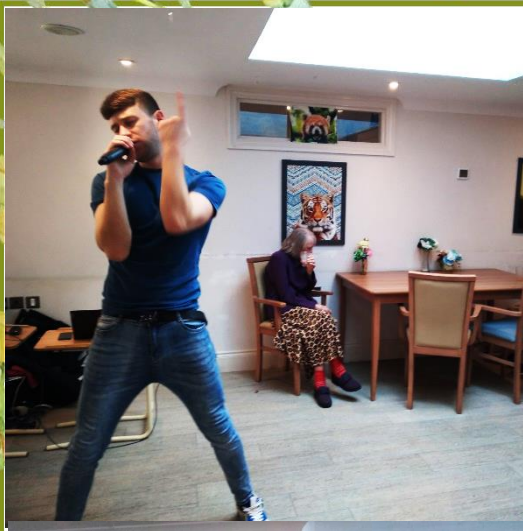
