We have also been getting into making Easter decorations with paint, stickers and little yellow chicks.

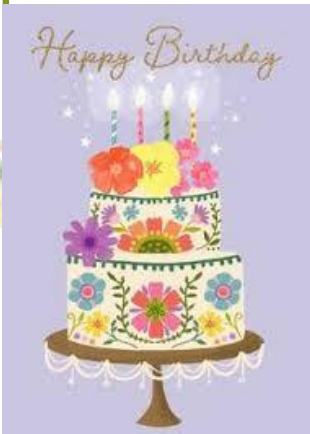


Each month we will include a contribution from a resident in our newsletter so now over to Jac...

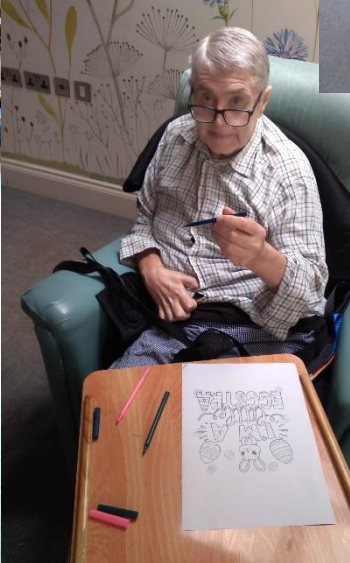
