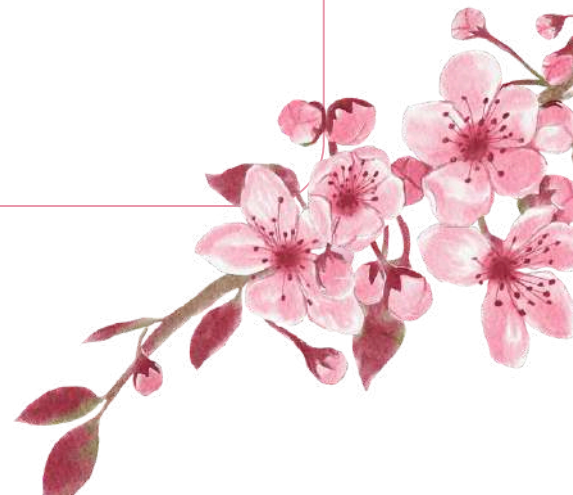


**The Sunday routine is attending the nearby church for an hour. It brings comfort to the residents who attends mass. They participate in the prayers and join in singing the hymns.**
