Residents embraced a colourful “colour splash” painting activity, sharing laughter and fun filled memories from their youth. A perfect mix of creativity and connection.

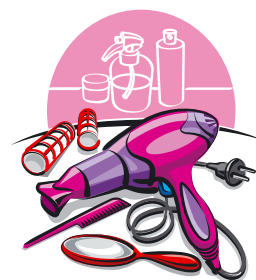
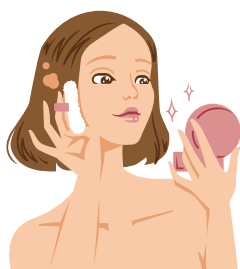
