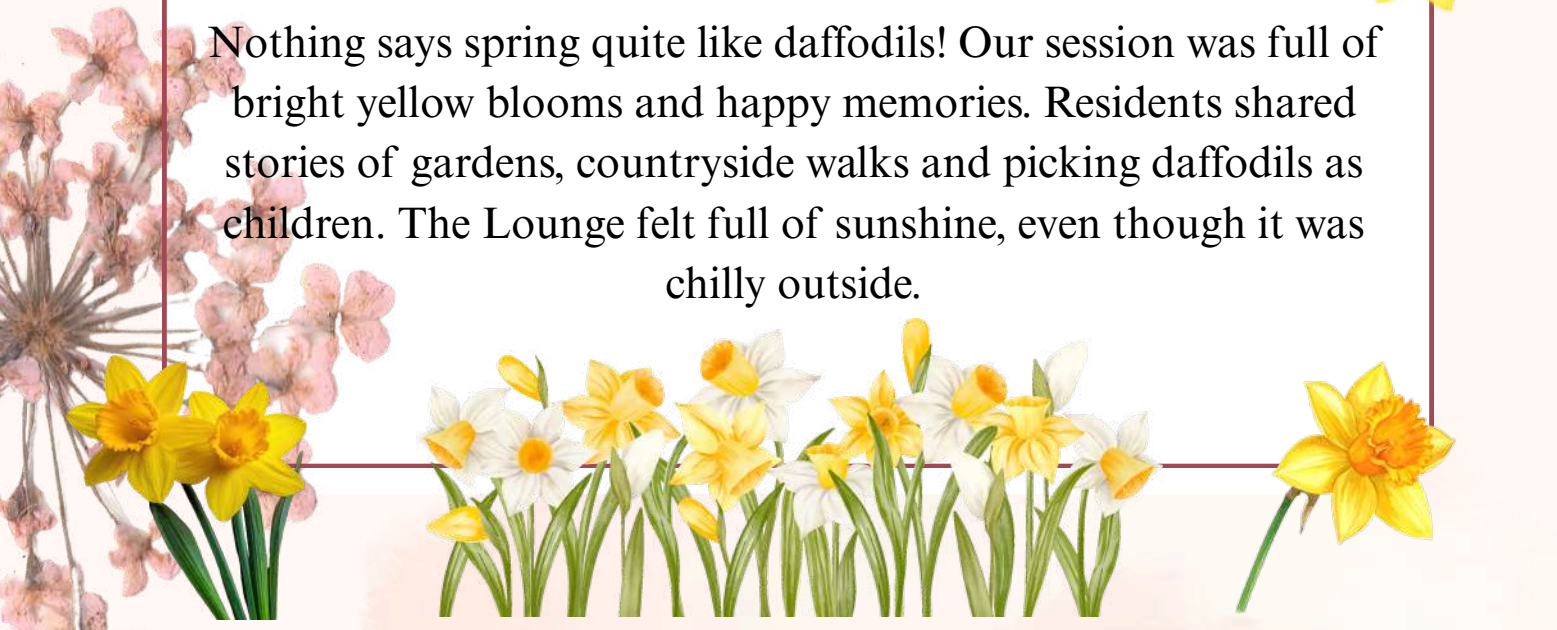


## Hello to all our families and friends!

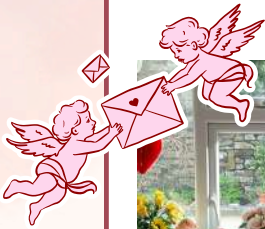

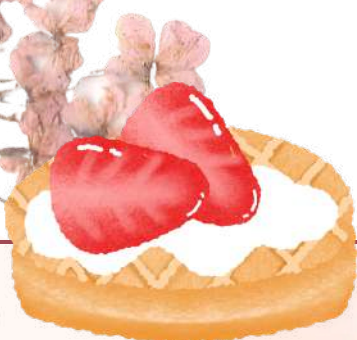
